COURAGEOUS INITIATIVE

PRIMARY GOAL: 100% ENGAGEMENT

We want each person at The Dwelling to grow in their faith through this Courageous initiative. This will be an opportunity to spend time listening to what God is saying to us as individuals and as a church regarding stewardship of our treasure, our time and our talents, in context of our relationship with Him. We believe God will provide everything needed as we each take a courageous faith step in following Him.

SECONDARY GOAL: \$2.25M

God has already done so much at The Dwelling, and we see a future where He continues to do even more! We see a vision for a Multi-Purpose Facility on our property as well as growth in our present ministry to reach even more disconnected people!

WHY MAKE THESE OUR PRIMARY GOALS?

This Courageous initiative is an opportunity for all of us to engage and support the ministry God is calling The Dwelling to, not only land and buildings, but also the entirety of being on mission, reaching disconnected people, starting new churches, and helping our people grow in their faith walk with Jesus. This Courageous initiative will be a faith growing opportunity as we each ask God what He is saying to us around our giving and generosity. It will impact each of us differently:

Those who already give - what is God saying?
Those who tithe - what is God saying?
Those who have never given - what is God saying?
Those who think the church is just after my money - what is God saying?
Those with their financial priorities in the wrong place - what is God saying?
Those who give, but don't do it with joy - what is God saying?

Our leaders recognize the need for a new multi-purpose facility. An increase in our regular giving will be required to make this possible. Although our time at the Yellow Rose and now Embassy have been true blessings from God, there are challenges if we remain, with a few noted here:

- Limits our capacity to reach more disconnected people.
- Don't have the weekly space available for larger group use, Bible studies, G2 groups in need of space, worship practice, youth events.
- Don't have space for home school co-ops, counseling sessions, community events, weddings, funerals etc.
- Limits what we can offer other church plants for office space or meetings.
- Expensive rent we could be putting towards a mortgage.
- Limiting the opportunity for another church being planted at Embassy.
- Doesn't show how committed we are to putting roots down in the community.

1 FUND / 2 YEARS / 3 INITIATIVES

ONE FUND INITIATIVE

Instead of giving toward multiple funds (general fund, building fund, etc.), we will be combining all generosity toward one Courageous initiative fund for the next 2 years. This will include fulfilling our everyday ministry (budget) as well as the future vision we are moving toward, one fund, two years, three initiatives (Ministry, Missions and New Facility).

1 FUND 2 YEARS 3 INITIATIVES

One of the most exciting things about a one fund initiative is that everyone who participates in Courageous will be able to say they are part of the entire ministry of The Dwelling. Not just the building. As we plant churches, witness baptisms, form new G2 groups, build a facility, etc, we will all be able to say "We give to that!"... "We are part of all of that!".

MINISTRY \$882K

This category represents two years of our ongoing operations at The Dwelling. These funds will be directed towards reaching more disconnected people and helping them become disciples of Jesus.

MISSIONS \$288K

The Dwelling strives to model generosity. A percentage of every dollar from this initiative will be used for church planting and our ministry partnerships. This is something our church has always done and wants to continue.

MULTI-PURPOSE FACILITY \$1.08M

This category represents the vision for a new multi purpose building to be placed on our property. This facility will provide new opportunities to reach into this region with our mission. Daily use, larger spaces for kids and worship, Bible studies, small groups and events, are just a few of the blessings we will see with this new facility.

MINISTRY

The Dwelling will continue to be a church where people can come as they are! Our mission of reaching disconnected people and helping them become disciples will be the primary focus for our Ministry dollars over the next two years. The following are a few examples of where we will put ministry dollars:

- Our Sunday worship as a safe place for people to come as they are.
- A full time worship leader/future church planter
- Small Group leader training / Establish new groups
- Equipping families to be the primary place of discipleship for our kids
- Supporting and raising up new evangelists and church planters
- Christ My Savior (our Hispanic church plant)
- Care for those in need through benevolence teams

As you give financially to the Courageous Campaign, those dollars will be used to continue the ministry God has called us to in this region!

MULTI-PURPOSE FACILITY

FUTURE BUILDING & LAND VISION

The Dwelling's land and buildings will be used in joyful service to Jesus and the mission and vision He has called us to. The land will help accomplish the needs of buildings, provide outdoor space for activities like Fire, Food, Friends, and be a resource for those joining Jesus on His mission. The initial building will be a simple design consisting of multipurpose spaces, specifically designed to support Sunday worship and to be a resource for The Dwelling's vision of gathering and going.

Specific needs:

- Designed with disconnected people in mind
- Multipurpose and Welcoming space for up to 250 worshippers
- Flexible seating
- Multipurpose and Safe space for Little Dwellers
- Multipurpose spaces used by church and community groups

Examples include:

- G2 groups (small groups)
- Bible studies
- Athletics
- Youth and children's activities
- Banquets
- Homeschool groups
- Church planting initiatives
- Parking for up to 100 cars
- Kitchen facilities
- Additional land to support growth for The Dwelling's mission





PHASES APPROACH

As we take steps toward putting a Multi-Purpose Facility on our property, our leadership sees the need to take a "phase" approach to development. Due to costs, as well as our desire for some "sweat equity", we see the facility being developed over 4 phases. The later phases may be accomplished through some "do it ourself" work. The Courageous campaign is focused on funds to be raised to start phases 1 and 2.

PHASE 1

Land developed (This is already in motion)

PHASE 2


Shell of building, bathrooms, kitchen, pavilion (Constructed with contractor)

PHASE 3

Build out interior first floor (Do this ourselves, utilize a contractor, or a combination of both)

PHASE 4>>>

Build out interior second floor (Do this ourselves, utilize a contractor, or a combination of both)



HELPFUL TOOLS TO PRAYERFULLY CONSIDER:

On the following page you will see both a "Commitment Card" and a "Giving Chart". These are tools for you to use as you walk through the discipleship process of asking Jesus how He would have you courageously respond during this initiative.

The Commitment Card shown here is a picture of an actual card we will ask each family from The Dwelling to fill out and bring with them on Commitment Sunday (March 30th). After the commitment card has been filled out, everyone will be asked to come forward and lay their commitment card on the altar to the Lord. As you study the card, allow it to stretch you as you consider where you are now in your giving, and how the Lord may be calling you to take a courageous step of faith.

The Giving Chart is a tool showing a possible way for our church to reach our goal. This is not meant to be a way to show who gives more or who gives less. Each of us are at different places in regards to our giving. We are all called to be faithful to what God is saying. To reach our goal, it will take each of us taking a courageous step no matter where we find ourselves on this chart. You are encouraged to consider where on this chart looks "comfortable" and what section on this chart might represent a courageous commitment from you.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What if I have never given to The Dwelling before?

Courageous was crafted specifically with you in mind. Courageous is a "one fund" generosity initiative. It's different from a traditional capital campaign where you are called to give an extra gift above and beyond your normal giving, thus creating two steps for people who aren't yet giving. Courageous is a call to sacrificial, gospel-centered generosity for everyone at The Dwelling. If you have never given before, this is your opportunity to get in the game. We really hope you will.

Are there additional ways I can give toward Courageous?

Be creative as you explore ways you and your family can give toward Courageous. You might have some stocks, property, or other items of that nature. You may have stored resources that God has blessed you with in the past that He just might be calling you to give during this time.

How is Courageous different from previous generosity initiatives?

We are focused on everyone at The Dwelling seeing their giving as an integral part of the discipleship process, and then being challenged by God to take a next step. The bulk of this notebook is focused on helping us dig into some key Biblical principles that guide us in this area as we follow Jesus. This is our first priority—100% engagement in the process. Even if someone wrote us a check today for our secondary goal of \$2.25M, we would still do this initiative. Whether we're just starting in our giving journey or we're very committed givers, we all have a next step to take and room to grow in this area.

What are cost estimates for phases 1 and 2 of a multi-purpose facility?

Initial cost estimates range from \$2.5M - \$3.4M (including contingency costs of up to 20%) for phase 1 and 2 of the multi-purpose facility. The congregation has approved a project cost of no more than \$3.4M dollars for these two phases. Once we begin receiving bids, we will have much more clarity around the cost.

If we hit our financial goal, will we begin building the new facility?

Our Senior Leadership Team will take the results from our Courageous Campaign and spend time deliberating and praying about what percent of debt The Dwelling is able to take on without negatively effecting our mission and vision as a church. Fluctuating material costs and mortgage rates will all play into this.

What if we don't hit our financial goal?

We will continue operating focused on our mission and vision. Any dollars raised over and above the needs for ministry and missions will be saved for next steps around our future facility. It may be a situation where we need to simply wait a few more years before moving forward with construction.

Do we have a consultant helping us through this campaign?

Yes, The Dwelling hired a consultant through the company Generis. You can read about them at Generis.com.

When would construction start on a building?

If our Senior Leadership Team feels good about the results from the campaign, is comfortable about cost estimates and continues to feel the Lord is still moving in this direction, we could break ground as early as the beginning of 2026.

Would we be able to worship in the new facility if we're able to complete phase 1 & 2?

Absolutely! We would be able to use the facility with the completion of phase 2.

What are you asking me to do?

First and foremost, we are asking that you pray and seek God's direction for how He is asking you to grow in giving and generosity as a follower of Christ in this season. Prepare your heart to hear Him and then listen to what He says. In obedience, take your next step. Engage in personal reflection with God in this guide. Talk with your spouse, your family, or others about what this commitment will mean for this season of your life. Finally, we are asking that you make a sacrificial commitment to gospel-centered generosity—whatever it is that God leads you to do. Follow His leading.

Please mark your calendar for Commitment Sunday, March 30 and prepare to experience a defining moment for our church and our own faith.

What if I am new around here?

Courageous is about the vision for our church and our personal discipleship in giving as followers of Jesus. We believe that the local church is one of the most worthy missions. If you choose to plant roots and make The Dwelling your home church, we invite you to join us in Courageous when you are ready.

WHAT'S NEXT?

Be Courageous! Will you journey with God and your family to take the biggest step of generosity you've ever taken? It will take courage to spend time listening to what Jesus is asking at this time. God will speak to each of us in different ways, and He will guide us and provide for us if we let Him.

1. READ AND REFLECT

Begin reading scripture. At the end of this guidebook is a Bible reading plan, which talks about giving and generosity. God has so much to say on these topics and as we allow His Word to speak, He will begin to shape us. Spend time reflecting on what God might be saying to you. Talking with others in our families about fears, questions we might have, and God's promises will be important.

2. PRAY

Pray that God would use this initiative to grow our faith. Begin asking God how He would have you and your family respond. Pray that He would do abundantly more than we ask or imagine. Consider setting a phone alarm each day at 5:07pm (*2 Corinthians 5:7*). Join others in prayer at that time each day.

3. ENGAGE

Help us reach our goal of 100% engagement. During the month of March: Attend each of our Sunday gatherings, study God's Word with your small group, read through the Courageous Bible reading plan, and ask God what He is saying to you through all of this.

4. GIVE GENEROUSLY

After you have asked God to show you what it looks like to give in a way that changes you, take the courageous faith step He is asking of you.


